Exhibited bulls do **not** have to be AI certified. **All participants will need to sign the Show Waiver form.**

Entry fee: \$400/bull

What's included:

1. Special animal and owner recognition as bull enters the arena during the CALL OF THE HORNS—where one free measurement will be provided
2. A 10' X 20' pen with hay (optional) and water will be provided
3. Bulls will be housed in a designated area for public viewing during the Champ Show
